

"Think about the best things that have happened to you lately. If you're a Christian who has received a promotion, a raise, a new car, a bigger home, a

newer home, a good report from the doctor, a healthy baby delivered, or that job you've always wanted...you've probably said these words:

'God is so good!' And you're absolutely right... He is.

But could there be more to His goodness than just the bright side of your story? It seems like our first response when things are going right is to declare His goodness, but the Bible paints a picture of God's character of goodness even in the darker times. Was God still good when He allowed Satan to afflict Job with suffering? Was God still good when He didn't answer Paul's prayer to remove the torment of Satan via the thorn in the flesh? ## PASSAGE DISCUSSION SERMON NOTES Isaiah 26:20-27:13 "God's Treatment of His People" 1. Read Genesis 7:1, 16, and Exodus 12:22-23. What parallels do you see with Isaiah 26:20? What does this tell you about God? 2. What does Isaiah mean in 27:7? How can this comfort you today? 3. In 27:8, Isaiah says that God has dealt out his discipline "measure by measure". This means that the discipline that we've experienced has been measured out perfectly by God. Why is this truth important to understand? 4. In 27:4, God is speaking about the thorns and thistles (unbelieving people) that He will destroy so that they can no longer harm His people. Yet, verse five makes a shocking offer. What is God offering to those unbelieving people? 5. One of the key truths in this passage is that God's people don't receive the same type of punishments that His enemies do. Think of the answer to this next question - "Why is God good for Him to

give you, a believer, the trials that you face in this life?"
