I will teach biblical truth to my family and acquaintances, as God gives me opportunity, with a desire to see them come to trust Jesus Christ and be saved.


I will always be willing to both give and receive admonition and instruction with meekness and in love.



# PASSAGE DISCUSSION

## SERMON NOTES

## Isaiah 28

#### "Surprise Rejecters of God's Word"

1. Read 28:5. God's true people think of him as a crown of glory and a diadem of beauty. What does that mean? Examine your heart. Do you think of God like this? If not, be honest with Him about this and ask Him to forgive you and change you.

2. While we don't think of ourselves as those who scoff at God's Word, are there any ways that you belittle or ignore God's Word? Do you fail to mediate on His Word, or fail to apply His Word?

3. If your answers to either Q.2 or Q.3 revealed your failures in any way, read 2 Corinthians 5:21 to remember that Christ has taken your sin and given you His righteousness.

4. Why does 28:21 say "strange is His deed"?

5. Read 28:23-29. Why does God tell us that He is the one who has given knowledge to farmers about how to plant and harvest crops?
