



## *The London Baptist Confession of 1689*

### XIII. Of Sanctification

1. They who are united to Christ, Effectually called, and regenerated, having a new heart, and a new Spirit created in them, through the virtue of Christ's death, and Resurrection; are also <sup>a</sup>farther sanctified, really, and personally, through the same virtue, <sup>b</sup>by his word and Spirit dwelling in them; <sup>c</sup>the dominion of the whole body of sin is destroyed, <sup>d</sup>and the several lusts thereof, are more and more weakened, and mortified; and they more and more quickened, and <sup>e</sup>strengthened in all saving graces, to the <sup>f</sup>practice of all true holiness, without which no man shall see the Lord.



2. This Sanctification is <sup>a</sup>throughout, in the whole man, yet imperfect <sup>b</sup>in this life; there abideth still some remnants of corruption in every part, whence ariseth a <sup>c</sup>continual, and irreconcilable war; the Flesh lusting against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the Flesh.

3. In which war, although the remaining corruption for a time may much <sup>a</sup>prevail; yet through the continual supply of strength from the sanctifying Spirit of Christ the <sup>b</sup>regenerate part doth overcome; and so the Saints grow in Grace, perfecting holiness in the fear of God, <sup>c</sup>pressing after an heavenly life, in Evangelical Obedience to all the commands which Christ as Head and King, in his Word hath prescribed to them.

### Nursing Mothers' Room


