


Book of the Month

"...God is not a meme. He's not a caricature nor a cartoon. He is high and lifted up, transcendent above all His creation. His holiness is not something we can withstand or ignore. As Habakkuk tells us, one day "the earth will be filled with the knowledge of the LORD's glory, as the water covers the sea" (2:14). Though we have been made clean by the sacrifice of Christ, we must not treat His holiness lightly or casually. God is not a lucky charm. Our circumstances are not more important than His glory. And we must not arrogantly decide to trample on His holiness by doing what's right in our own eyes."
