I will always be willing to both give and receive admonition and instruction with meekness and in love.


I will commit to praying for the ministry here in this church, my brothers and sisters in Christ, the elders, pastors, and deacons; and for the lost who need the Savior.



For dinner that night, I'd roasted some potatoes and seared some spicy chicken (which my sevenyear-old deemed way too hot). Before we ate, we

grabbed hands as my husband prayed. He mentioned some news of the day in his prayer, things we wanted to remember before the Lord. A couple from church had suddenly lost an adult child that morning, which I'd learned through a heartbreaking phone call from the bereaved mother that afternoon. He prayed for them, his voice tightening, then breaking. It's difficult to know how to pray for such a grievous loss.

After the "amen," my teenager asked, "Now who are they again? The ones who lost their son?" I reminded him of their names—they're relatively new to the church. I described their appearances and where they usually sit in the sanctuary, but he cut me off: "Oh, I know them. Are they the ones who pray all the time?"

"Yes, that's them." I nodded. "They pray with anyone and everyone at a moment's notice." I paused and looked at my husband—"Gosh, that's how I'd like to be known. The one who prays all the time."
