Kids Training Center for Worship

We have two rooms available for parents as they seek to train their kids to attend the worship service. The Family Life Center and the Mom's Room (Room 207 in Cap Kids) are there for the little ones and parents to use as they worship. The Mom's room is designed for moms to provide care for their infants. The FLC Training Center is designed for families with young children who need extra support during worship service. Both rooms live-stream the service and are comfortable for families to train infants and small children for the future.

Men's and Women's Bible Studies
