**Apply:** By remembering that a believer's faith should be accompanied by deeds.

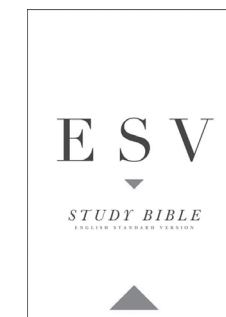
**This Week:** As a family, read Joshua 2:1-24.
