PHASE 1 – Beginning May 31st at 10 AM

- 1. In-person Sunday morning worship service
- 2. Attendance limited to around 100 people (Sign up required online)
- 3. Ushers will seat households together, 6 feet from other families, leaving 3 chairs between them and skipping every other row.
- Designated rooms with livestream available for families with small children (infant to 5 years old)
- 5. No nursery or Jr. Church provided
- 6. Livestream available for those who continue to shelter in place
- 7. Sunday Adult Life Group time changed to 5 PM via livestream
- 8. Teen Life Group at 5 PM Sunday via livestream

SOCIAL DISTANCING PROTOCOL

- 1. Do not attend if you are not feeling well, have a fever, cough, difficulty breathing, sore throat or have had direct contact with someone who likely has or is confirmed to have COVID-19.
- 2. Please utilize the hand-sanitation stations at each of the entrances.
- 3. Bathrooms will be limited to 2 people at a time and water fountains will be closed.
- 4. Family members are allowed to sit together.
- We will try to seat people according to strict social-distancing guidelines, leaving 6 feet in all directions between each household unit.
- 6. We will not hand out bulletins.

- 7. Offering plates will not be passed. Online giving will continue. Those wanting to give in person will be directed to the offering box at the back of auditorium.
- 8. Greeters will keep social distancing, and there will be no handshake time.
- 9. Facemasks and gloves are welcomed and encouraged, but not mandatory.
- 10. Main doors will remain open during service times.
- 11. All attendees should enter and leave the building through the main lobby and auditorium doors.
 - 2. Please do not congregate in the hallways or other common areas. Plan to be seated upon arrival. At the end, each row will be dismissed sequentially. Feel free to congregate outside after dismissal.

PHASE 2 – Date TBD

- 1. Sunday mornings remain the same as Phase 1.
- 2. There will be a limited nursery on Sunday morning for toddlers only.
- 3. Wednesday night service for all ages will be held at the church building.
- 4. Adults will be in the auditorium while the kids have "Live Out Loud" class and the teens have youth group.
- 5. There will be no nursery on Wednesday nights.
- 6. Livestream for Wednesday will still be available.

- 4. Limited Nursery during Life Group (for toddlers only)
- Limited church-wide activities.
 (e.g., Life Group, kids', & teen activities)

- 1. Sunday morning worship service resumes to normal seating and attendance.
- 2. Adult Life Groups resume to normal.
- 3. Nursery resumes to full and normal schedule.
- 4. All church-wide activities resume to normal schedule.

RECAP

- PHASE 1 Start gathering together for a Sunday Morning Worship service.
- PHASE 2 Bring back our Wednesday Night service with teen and kids' classes.
- PHASE 3 Bring back a combined Adult Life Group with teens and kids in classes. Start to have a few activities.
- PHASE 4 Return to a completely normal schedule.



NOTE OF CONCERN

With concern for the safety and well-being of our congregation, we encourage that those who are 65 or older, or those with serious underlying health conditions, including high blood pressure, chronic lung disease, diabetes, asthma, and those whose immune systems are compromised, to continue to view the live broadcasts from home.
