50 Year History of Christian Bible Fellowship (CBF): "A Church always on the Move"

In the beginning: 1965 - 1971 The vision for reaching and ministering to Filipinos living and working around the world has always been the response of a Filipino countryman to the biblical mandate of the Great Commission. One such countryman named Dr. Frank Obien was obedient to God's calling to the vision. He was the personal secretary of Dr. Bill Bright, founder of Campus Crusade. Dr. Obien was tasked with his wife (Rose Marie Lorenzana) to organize the work of the Campus Crusade in the Philippines in 1965 where they met Pastor Bayani Mendoza who was pastor of the Alliance Church of Quezon City, Philippines. Dr. Obien challenged Pastor Mendoza to consider working among Filipinos in America. Upon returning to America in 1968, Dr. Obien, along with his parents (Dr. Ernie Obien & his wife Avelina) launched the Philippine Ministries for Christ in America (PMCA) to help plant Filipino churches in America which will initiate the beginning of the future CBF.

Panorama City: 1971 - 1974 With the assistance of Dr. John MacArthur and partnership with Grace Community Church (Sun Valley, California), Pastor Mendoza was called to lead the Philippine Ministries for Christ in America-Southern California, in 1971. The first PMCA service was held at the Thanksgiving Celebration Service at Grace Community Church. As a result of Bible Studies in the years 1972-1973, held in the homes of fellow countrymen such as the families of the Libatiques, the Primaveraes, and the Hilarios, to name a few, to form the core group who will subsequently plant a Filipino-American church in the Los Angeles area.

Hollywood, California: 1974 - 1975 In February 1974, men with the vision namely: Pastor Mendoza, Pastor Luong, Peter Lieve, and Prudencio Ganzon, drafted and signed the Articles of Incorporation of the church and was registered on March 1974 as the "Hollywood Bible Fellowship", and the congregation met at the World Opportunities Headquarters in Hollywood, California.

Van Nuys, California: 1975 - 1976 In February of 1975, the church moved to the facility of the Missionary Alliance Church (Van Nuys, California) and changed the church name to "Pilipino Bible Fellowship."

Alhambra, California: 1976 - 1982 The church moved to Alhambra in October 1976 with Pastor Ed Lacaba becoming the Interim Pastor and the church began to grow as new families were added. Pastor Ben Cabral became pastor in 1977 and served until 1984. In February 1978, the church moved to the Calvary Baptist Church facility, also in Alhambra, where the church membership greatly expanded. In November 1978, the name was changed to "Christian Bible Fellowship" (CBF). In September 1981, the church affiliated with the Conservative Baptist Association of Southern California (CBASC).

Rosemead, California: 1982 - 1987 In April 1982, the church moved to Hope Union Free Evangelical Church facility in Rosemead and in 1985 Pastor Emil Boniog became the pastor.

Covina, California: 1988 - 1990 In May of 1988, the church moved to the Covina Methodist Church facility in Covina.

Montebello, California 1990 – 1997; Alhambra 1997 – 2003 The church merged in July of 1990 with another Filipino-American church called New Life Calvary Chapel with Pastor Ernie Montealegre. The merged church kept the name CBF while moving to the First Baptist Church of Montebello. However, Pastor Boniog was called to shepherd a church in Seattle thus Pastor Montealegre became the pastor of CBF. In 1993 Pastor Montealegre and CBF explored the possibility of starting a sister church in Northridge, California. That led to the planting of the Northridge Christian Fellowship in 1994 under Pastor Montealegre which later moved to the Simi Valley and is now called the Christian Fellowship Church. Subsequently, Pastor Norman Decena became the pastor of CBF that same year. In April 1997, the church moved to the Unity Church facility in Alhambra and met there until June of 2003.

Arcadia, California: 2003 – 2014 On June, 2003 CBF moved to the Lutheran Church of the Cross. On January, 2005, Dr. Oscar Baldemor (a former staff of Campus Crusade Philippines, former officer of various Conservative Baptist associations, and a church planter) was invited to be the pastor of CBF. In organizing the Campus Crusade Philippines, Dr. Baldemor was a member of the leadership associated with Dr. Obien. Dr. Baldemor also invited Pastor Jem Mendoza and his wife, Maricar, the son of the founding Pastor Bayani Mendoza, at CBF. Even before CBF was formed these three (3) individual pastors were providentially connected with each other. The Lord brought these men to CBF, this team of Pastors lead CBF for next decade. Most of the years under Pastor Oscar's leadership were served in Lutheran Church of the Cross in Arcadia, CA. Due to the lease agreement, CBF had to move again. On July 13, 2014, CBF held its first worship service at the new place in Temple City. Towards the end of that year, Pastor Oscar delivered his last sermon of his pastoral tenure on Dec 14, 2014.

Temple City, Covina, California: 2015 – 2017 On February 15, 2015, Pastor Eric Tibayan was installed as the new pastor of CBF. CBF started experiencing some growing pains, and the place at Temple City was no longer big enough to accommodate the growing congregation. CBF found a building on Lark Ellen Avenue, Covina that was suitable for the new growth trend. On October 11, 2015, CBF held their first worship service at this new place, where they were meeting for the next two years.

Covina, California: 2017 – to the Present At the end of the two-year lease on Lark Ellen Avenue, CBF decided to move to a new place that was more affordable, at the Sonrise Christian School in Covina where CBF is currently meeting now and held their first worship service at Sonrise on October 1, 2017. On March 2020, Pastor Jon Dignadice became the interim pastor of CBF. And on May 2021 Pastor Omer Mascarina, an acquaintance and a good friend in the ministry was installed as Lead Pastor along with Pastor Joel Valenciano' also an acquaintance in the ministry of Pastor Omer and Pastor Jon, as the Community of Life Pastor. CBF was blessed to have not one but two (2) Godly men to continue the journey to "Love God, Love people, Make Disciple" and to put into action our vision of 1-1-1, (1 church plant in L.A. led by Elder Dan, 1 church plant in the Philippines among the Dumagat Tribes, 1 restart church plant in Riverside County. Pray and partner with us as we ask God for His blessing in this endeavor. The journey of the Christian Bible Fellowship is truly one that only God could orchestrate. We look with great anticipation for what God is going to do in reaching the goals of the church in the next few years. We give God all the glory and praise. His will and purpose be done. Eph. 3:21 "To him be glory in the church and in Christ Jesus to all generation forever and ever."

I started going to church at 2 weeks old. My parents were eager for me to be exposed to the love of God. However, as a child, I did not fully grasp the importance of God and the church community. It wasn't until my mother shared the gospel to little 6-year-old me did I begin to understand that Sundays were not just for hanging out with the other kids at church. That same day, my mother held my hand while she guided me through a prayer where I repented for my past and future sins, asked God for forgiveness, and accepted Jesus as my Lord and Savior. Even at a young age, I felt the importance of that moment and understood that it would change my life. Over the years, I began to absorb the Sunday teachings and was excited to serve the church in any way. God became my crutch through all the good and bad times which was evident in the way I lived. Unfortunately, after a few unkind words from some classmates at school, I was not keen to share my source of hope with friends outside of the church. I was perfectly happy with staying in my comfort zone and exclusively discussing Christianity with fellow church mates who would not judge me for my beliefs. Later, I was invited to the Christian Club at my high school. There, I saw wonderful examples for believers unafraid to spread the teachings of God. I asked members of the club how they remained enthusiastic about evangelizing despite the discomfort that often comes with it. They simply answered, "The love of God is the greatest gift you can give". I had heard this exact phrase spoken by adults many times in the past, but I always brushed it off because I didn't think they understood the pressures of a teenager trying to fit in. However, hearing it from someone my age proved that even I could prioritize the need to spread God's love over the discomfort and occasional discouragement of evangelism. Though I am still a work in progress, I continue to challenge myself every day and remind myself that spreading God's word is the best service I can provide to those around me. -Rebekah Mendoza

I received Jesus into my heart when I was 9 years old. My parents had taken me to church with them since I was 3, but I didn't understand why Jesus had to die for me until much later. I started playing guitar at 12, and bass at 14, so when I was in Junior High school, I started to play in church for choir tours and in Sunday School. As a first-year college student, I auditioned for and was able to join an outreach band from First Baptist Church of Van Nuys, called "The Certain Sounds", and was blessed to play music while sharing the love of Christ to people in Japan, Korea, England, Sweden, and on the beaches of Hawaii. After four years in the Certain Sounds, I felt called to join a group called "Language Institute for Evangelism", which teams up with local Japanese churches to teach English classes as an evangelism tool to reach those Japanese living in the neighborhoods around the churches. I was sent to a small church on the outskirts of Kobe and was blessed to see some of my students there come to know the Lord. I was later told that one of those had even become a pastor. After that program ended, I stayed in Japan to do the same thing helping out World Vision in another part of Osaka. After that, I was introduced to a pastor who was looking for an American missionary with music experience to work with his young people and direct their choir, which I did for one year. By that time, I decided to take a break from missionary work, which in hindsight, was not the best decision. I fell away from the Lord for many years, but fortunately He brought me back. A friend of mine told me about a group of Christians that met at my son's International School, and I felt that, after trying to live on my own without Him and really messing up, I needed Him in my life again. It was then that I rededicated my life to following Him. After 31 years of living in Japan, I returned to live in the U.S. in 2006, and was blessed to have four years with my mother before she passed away. I was introduced to CBF in 2007 as an assistant to Dr. Frank Obien to help out in the music ministry and have been there ever since. Praise God for His love and forgiveness! And thank you Jesus for your sacrifice...that I might have eternal life in Him! I feel God chose me for a purpose and stuck by me even when I didn't want to be close to Him. Amen. - John Bury
