- Collaborate with the other members of the Leadership Team to develop and implement a church-wide Discipleship Process to put our Disciple-making Mission (Teach the Word, Live the Word, Serve the World) into practice more effectively.

Qualifications

- Demonstrate the capacity to teach the Scriptures in one-on-one and large group environments.
- Have experience in disciple-making: from outreach to not-yet-believers through to being disciples who make disciples.
- Demonstrate gifting in pastoral care.
- Have the capacity to equip and lead ministry leaders.
- Be able to align with the Mennonite Brethren Confession of Faith.
