Heidelberg Catechism Questions 56-58

Q. 56: What do you believe concerning the forgiveness of sins?

Answer: I believe that God, because of Christ's satisfaction, will no more remember my sins, nor my sinful nature, against which I have to struggle all my life, but that He will graciously grant me the righteousness of Christ, so that I may never come into condemnation.

Q. 57: What comfort does the resurrection of the body offer you?

Answer: Not only shall my soul after this life immediately be taken up to Christ, my Head, but also this my flesh, raised by the power of Christ, shall be reunited with my soul and made like Christ's glorious body.

Q. 58: What comfort do you receive from the article about the life everlasting?
