




Cause of Reformation

- Formal cause: Sola Scriptura, binding authority




REVIEW



- Analogy of faith:

- Genre analysis, metaphors, simile, parables, hyperboles, parallelisms, Hebrew and Greek styles



REVIEW



- •Inspired:
 - God enabled human writers to be agents of divine revelation
- Infallible: in its origin, has no error
- Authority: resides in the Bible and God, not in man



WHAT IS A COVENANT?




- An Agreement

 - the bank-- give you the loan

 - Sign (or seal): wedding rings, the vows
 - Witnesses





REVIEW: DEFINITION OF COVENANT

"The gospel set forth in the context of God's eternal plan of communication with His people as it unfolds in the historical outworking of the redemptive plan of God. Covenant theology is central to the message of the Scriptures, which testify to God's redemption of His people in and through the finished work of Jesus Christ."

1. PARTIES TO THE COVENANT

 God and Adam, acting as the representative (federal head) of all mankind

Adam and Eve understood the nature of the covenant




 And the woman said to the serpent, "We may eat of the fruit of the trees in the garden, but God said, 'You shall not eat of the fruit of the tree that is in the midst of the garden, neither shall you touch it, lest you die.' "

(Genesis 3:2-3)

ADAM ACTED FOR ALL MEN?

- Adam's penalty passed onto the entire human race
- The Bible teaches that Adam was our representative
 - •Romans 5:12-21






2. CONDITION: OBEDIENCE

•What did Adam have to obey?

 The will of God was expressed in a positive command.

4. THREAT FOR DISOBEDIENCE

Death

 And the Lord God commanded the man, saying, "You may surely eat of every tree of the garden, but of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil you shall not eat, for in the day that you eat of it you shall surely die." (Genesis 2:16-17)

THEWATIC UNITY

• We see the unity in **Ephesians 2:12**:

 "remember that you were at that time separated from Christ, alienated from the commonwealth of Israel and strangers to the covenants of promise, having no hope and without God in the world."



THEWATIC UNITY

 And I will establish my covenant between me and you and your offspring after you throughout their generations for an everlasting covenant, to be God to you and to your offspring after you. And I will give to you and to your offspring after you the land of your sojournings, all the land of Canaan, for an everlasting possession, and I will be their God. (Genesis 17.7-8)



THEWATIC UNITY

 Say therefore to the people of Israel, 'I am the LORD, and I will bring you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians, and I will deliver you from slavery to them, and I will redeem you with an outstretched arm and with great acts of judgment. I will take you to be my people, and I will be your God, and you shall know that I am the LORD your God, who has brought you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians. (Exodus 6:6-7



THEWATIC UNITY

- I will be to him a father, and he shall be to me a son. When he commits iniquity, I will discipline him with the rod of men, with the stripes of the sons of men (2 Samuel 7:14)
- But this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, declares the LORD: I will put my law within them, and I will write it on their hearts. And I will be their God, and they shall be my people. (Jeremiah 31:33)



THEWATIC UNITY

- And Jehoiada made a covenant between himself and all the people and the king that they should be the LORD's people (2 Chronicles 23:16)
- And I heard a loud voice from the throne saying, "Behold, the dwelling place of God is with man. He will dwell with them, and they will be his people, and God himself will be with them as their God. (Rev. 21:3)



ORGANIC UNITY

The <u>Unity</u> of the Covenant of Grace is more than just the fact that the whole Bible speaks about the same subject





NOAHIC COVENANT



But I will establish my covenant with you, and you shall come into the ark, you, your sons, your wife, and your sons' wives with you. (Genesis 6:18)



ABRAHAVIC COVENANT



And I will establish my covenant between me and you and your offspring after you throughout their generations for an everlasting covenant, to be God to you and to your offspring after you. (Genesis 17:7)



MOSAIC COVENANT



""Behold, I am making a covenant. Before all your people I will do marvels, such as have not been created in all the earth or in any nation. And all the people among whom you are shall see the work of the LORD, for it is an awesome thing that I will do with you." (Exodus 34:10)

DAVIDIC COVENANT



You have said, "I have made a covenant with my chosen one; I have sworn to David my servant: 'I will establish your offspring forever, and build your throne for all generations. (Psalm 89:3-4)



NEW COVENANT



 this is my blood of the covenant, which is poured out for many for the forgiveness of sins (Matthew 26:28)

ORGANIC UNITY

- The Bible is not a series of unrelated events only tied together by the presence of God
- There is one single way in which God deals with His people, redeems sinners, and manifests his glory
