

Ever wish you could read your Bible more often—but find yourself falling out of the habit? You're not alone! Many desire to read their Bibles more often but find it hard to maintain this essential habit alone. That's why we're starting a new Bible reading group at Central Bible Church, and it's all about helping each other actually follow through. Every week, we'll meet up, read a few chapters out loud, pray together, and chat about what stood out. It's friendly, low-pressure, and open to anyone, no matter your age or background.

The New Testament gives clear encouragement: "Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly, teaching and admonishing one another in all wisdom" (Colossians 3:16). In the Psalms, the Bible says, "Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path" (Psalm 119:105), and being part of a group helps keep that lamp burning steadily.

No need to register or prepare in advance—just come as you are, bring a Bible, and let's start a life-changing new habit together. We kicked things off Saturday, October 18 at 6 PM and we will keep meeting every Saturday night according to the schedule on the front. If you've ever wanted a little motivation and some friendly accountability to really make Bible reading a part of your week, come join us. Everyone's welcome—see you there!

READING SCHEDULE HIGHLIGHTS

- The plan schedules readings to end at the conclusion of each chapter. Chapters are grouped to fit within each meeting's allotted reading time, always stopping at chapter boundaries
- Sessions typically cover several chapters, usually from 4 to 9 chapters of the New Testament per week, based on chapter length and total words.
- When chapters are short (esp. in Psalms and Proverbs), more chapters are covered per session. Long chapters (e.g., some in Acts or the Gospels) may limit the count for that week.
- The full set comprises 28 NT books + 31 Proverbs + 150 Psalms + 12 Ecclesiastes chapters = 350 chapters, grouped to fit weekly schedule.

HOW IT WORKS:

The group will meet every week for prayer, encouragement, and sequential Bible reading, covering the New Testament, Proverbs, Psalms, and Ecclesiastes—all within a single year.

Everyone is welcome. Each session features a short introduction, group Bible reading aloud (ending at a chapter break), prayer time, and closing announcements.

<u>Section (Time)</u>	<u>Details</u>
Opening Prayer and Book Overview (10 min)	Welcome, share intentions, introduce the day's reading, context, or key themes.
Bible Reading Aloud (40 min)	Take turns reading—example: "Matthew 1-9" (from plan). Pause at chapter ends for continuity.
Group Prayer Time (20 min)	Share prayer requests, pray together about group/reading topics or personal needs.
Closing Prayer & Announcements (5 min)	Wrap-up, thank readers, announce any group news or next readings.
