Registration & book fees must be paid in full to reserve your child's space.

The registration & book fees are non-refundable (the only exception to this rule is if your family is being transferred and will therefore not be living in this area). Tuition is paid monthly August through April—First month is due August 1, 2025. A 3.5% fee is added when paying with a credit card or PayPal as this is what they charge our preschool. Because operating expenses continue whether or not your child is present, payment is due even when your child misses class.

Students must reach the appropriate birthday by September 1, 2025. February 3-Registration opens to current students & their families & church members. March 3rd -Registration opens to the public.



We are always delighted to have new families at our school. We offer classes for children ages 1 through 5. Our school year begins near the end of August and concludes in May. Classes begin at 9 AM and end at noon. We pride ourselves in providing your child with a Christian learning environment where they can explore God's world and make new friends.

<u>Parent's Morning Out</u> is offered Tuesday through Thursday mornings in conjunction with our Preschool Program. The purpose of our PMO program is to offer young children the opportunity to play with children their own age in a safe and loving environment. PMO is available for children who have begun to walk and are one to two years of age who do not reach their second birthday by September 1, 2025.

Our <u>two year old classes</u> meet two days a week. They work on learning colors and shapes as well as what it is like to be in a classroom environment. The children study units that vary from seasons to types of transportation to community helpers. They enjoy learning Bible stories and attending weekly music classes.

Our <u>three year old classes</u> use the A-Beka curriculum for learning their alphabet and numbers. With each unit, they will explore the week's theme through music, art, and play. Three year olds attend Chapel on Tuesdays for approximately fifteen minutes where they say their pledges to the Christian and American flag and have a Bible story and singing time. They have fun going to music class weekly and playing on the playground or in the gym with their friends. <u>Students in three year old classes and up need to be potty trained</u>.

Our <u>K-4 and K-5 classes</u> use the A-Beka phonics based curriculum. The A-Beka curriculum offers children a fun way of learning vowel and consonant sounds. We have also incorporated manipulatives and learning games into our curriculum. Each day is full of fun and learning. They have weekly Bible verses that coordinate with their Bible story for the week, which they hear in chapel on Mondays. Each week they attend music class. They have fun celebrating different holidays and the themes of the week.

Our school is staffed by loving Christian teachers who have experience working with preschoolers. We are a ministry of Central Baptist Church and adhere to the beliefs of the church.
