## LODGING: There are two types of rooms, Lodge Rooms and Cabin Rooms



LODGE ROOMS are equipped with a bunk bed, a twin bed, and a double bed. They are like motel rooms which have their own full bathroom.

Unlike past years, no linens will be provided for these rooms. You will need to bring bed linens or sleeping bags, and your own towels.

The cost per person in a Lodge Room is:

\$175 adult (13yrs and older)

\$125 1<sup>st</sup> child (7yrs - 12yrs)

\$100 2<sup>nd</sup> child (7yrs - 12yrs)

Free 3<sup>rd</sup> child (7yrs - 12yrs) or more

Free Children (Oyrs - 6yrs)

Families will be given priority for the lodge rooms. However, we believe that there will be enough lodge rooms for those who desire to stay in them as long as people find roommates to share them.

CABIN ROOMS are like dorm rooms. We will likely have one men's cabin and one women's cabin, each with 12 beds available (6 bunkbeds). Youth will be supervised by a youth leader in the cabin rooms.

Each cabin has a set of shared showers and bathroom facilities.

The cost per person in a Cabin Room is:

\$135 adult (13yrs and older)

\$125 1st child (7yrs - 12yrs)

\$100 2<sup>nd</sup> child (7yrs - 12yrs)

Free 3<sup>rd</sup> child (7yrs - 12yrs) or more

Free Children (Oyrs - 6yrs)



Those in the Cabin Rooms will need to bring a sleeping bag and a pillow, and their own towels.

#### **ACTIVITIES:**

We will have a fun time of cool, community-building recreational activities for the whole family on Saturday afternoon. Archery and crafts will be available after that, during the late afternoon.

We will NOT be scheduling paintball or zipline at the retreat this year.
