The Case for Infant Baptism

1. The continuity in the "covenant of grace" shows that baptism is the new circumcision, and like circumcision it is to be given to the children of believers.

Colossians 2:11-12

- 2. The household baptisms in Acts show that in the new covenant God is still dealing with families as families.
- 3. Rejecting infant baptism kicks children out of the church.

The Problems with Infant Baptism

- 1. Infant baptism applies the sign of union with Christ to those who united to Christ.
- 2. Infant baptism confuses being born of Christian parents with being born again by the Spirit.
- 3. Infant baptism undermines the church's saltiness and lightness (Matthew 5:13-16).

4. Infant baptism makes God's new covenant promise less than a promise.
