The Problem of Premarital Sex

Introduction

Intimacy is the *reward, product, and fruit* of commitment, <u>not</u> the means to achieving it.

Not "How far can I go?" but instead "How can I serve and honor the person to whom I'm attracted and with whom I am pursing a dating relationship?"

Any sexual relationship outside of marriage is not part of the Biblical model and should be considered sinful.

Implications Truly loving someone in a dating context means not expressing that	Legalism – Seeing dating as an equation or law.
affection physically	Selfishness – Desiring marriage so much that you become
All sexual activity is "sex"	preoccupied and only concerned with your self.
There are ramifications for sinful sexual activity	Philippians 2:3-4 "Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit, but in humility consider others better than yourselves. Each of you should look not only to your own interests, but also to the interests of others."
Helpful principles	
Set clear guidelines	Song of Solomon 2:7b "Do not arouse or awaken love until it so desires."
Do not do anything that sexually arouses	
Avoid temptation	Proverbs 18:1 "Whoever isolates himself seeks his own desire; he breaks out against all sound judgment."
Have reliable accountability structures in place	
Look to Jesus as Savior and Sovereign	"Evange-dating" – Dating a non-Christian in hopes that they will become a Christian while dating.
