It has been a good week since we last communicated!

Thank you all for your support and encouragement.

We have received some donations and transferred remaining funds from the HVAC Fund (that is no longer needed) to fund the General Fund.

We will be paying \$220,000 on the Mortgage by the end of the week, leaving us a balance of approx. \$527,000.

Our new monthly payment will be \$3,907.88!

Traditions Bank has re-amortized our loan and will be saving us \$1,615 per month.
