Debt Elimination Team (DET) Updates

Encouragement for Chapel Family since refinancing mortgage September 2023:

- \rightarrow 20 year (240 months) amortization @ 6.25% monthly payment \$3,896
- → Beginning Balance: \$525,873 . . . Current Balance (7/26/24): **\$311,429.36**
- \rightarrow The current balance is \$13,662.63 less than reported in the July newsletter
- \rightarrow Total reduction in the past eleven months is \$214,444
- → Amount of interest paid since 2012: \$625,893




Hi Everyone,

Since 1985, Human Life Services (HLS) has been a life-affirming, Christ-centered pregnancy care organization serving York through medical services, peer counseling, education, and community referrals. They believe the most effective way to save a baby's life is to first care for the mother, who often finds herself alone and in a seemingly impossible situation. Reaching abortion-minded women in our community has always been at the heart of their ministry. No pregnant women should ever be limited by a lack of emotional support, finances, or the fear of judgment. Part of valuing life is supporting each life. Below are the services offered at HLS.

- Free pregnancy testing
- Free obstetrical ultrasounds
- Confidential counseling about pregnancy options
- Prenatal and parenting education
- Maternity and baby clothes
- Post-abortion recovery counseling
- Referrals for community services

We look forward to having a representative visit Chapel during both of our Worship Services to give an overview of their vital ministry to the York and surrounding communities.
