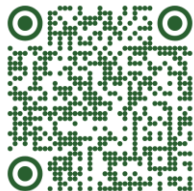
### **MARK YOUR CALENDARS FOR THESE IMPORTANT DATES:**

## Debt Elimination Team (DET) Updates

### Encouragement for Chapel Family since refinancing mortgage September 2023:

- 20 year (240 months) amortization @ 6.25% - monthly payment \$3,896
- Beginning Balance: \$525,873 . . . Current Balance (6/26/24): **\$325,091.99**
- The current balance is **\$9,841.59** less than reported in the June newsletter
- Total reduction in the past ten months is **\$200,781**
- Amount of interest paid since 2012: \$624,220

## **Mission Moment** – LifePath Christian Ministries (formerly York Rescue Mission)

LifePath Thrift Stores in South York, York, East York and Red Lion directly impact those they service. Profits from thrift store sales go directly into the work of their shelters so they can impact more lives for Christ. In addition, LifePath gives vouchers to those experiencing poverty so they can “shop” their stores for clothing and houseware.

Chapel will be partnering with LifePath to receive donations of clothes and housewares for their thrift stores. Chapel would receive “credit” for these donations which in turn will come to us as gift cards for the thrift stores that we can give out to folks who contact the church for help, including the Shower Ministry. Since January, 2023, Chapel has received gift cards totaling \$240.00. This happened when a donation was dropped off at one of their stores and we mentioned that Chapel was in their gift card program, and the number of bags you donated would add up to what we received in gift cards.

Now, here is the exciting update.... To make donating easier and perhaps more profitable for LifePath, **Chapel now has a bin on our property to receive donations**, perhaps you’ve seen them in parking lots of churches and other public locations. The bin will be emptied on a regular basis; we just ask that you not put your bagged donation outside the bin. As the bin will be emptied weekly, most likely will not be full and can even be picked up twice/week if need could arise.

The location of the bin will be at the side entrance of the Parish Building, between the kitchen door and the pavilion. You will easily spot this new addition to our campus and we urge you all to remember Chapel Church and the new bin as you bag up clothes and household items. Wrap up securely as your bag or box will be lowered into the bin.

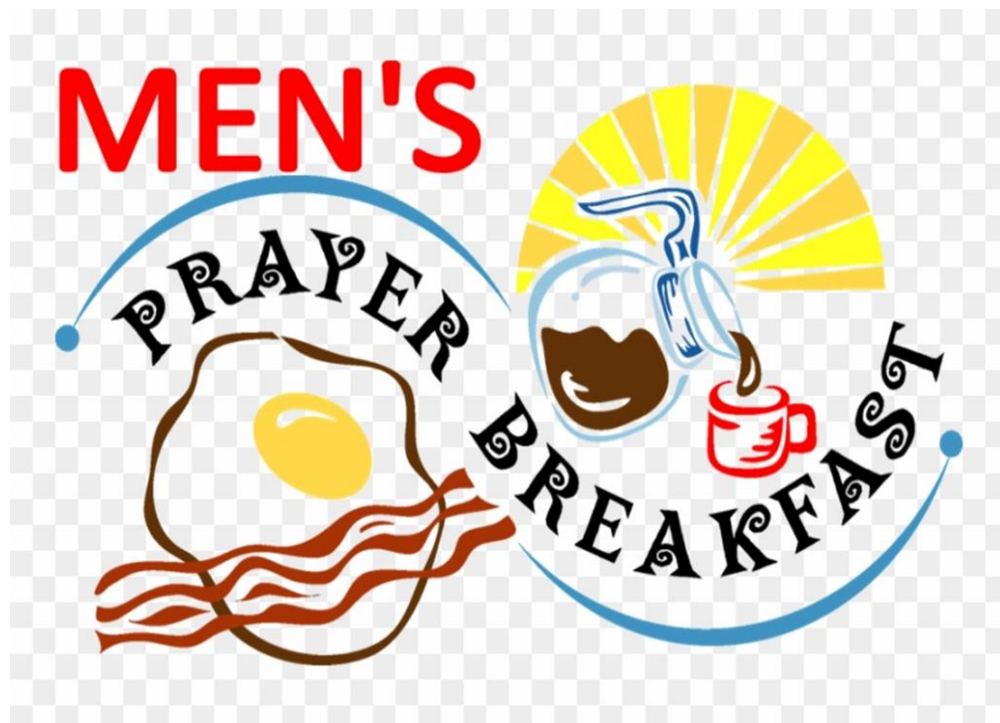

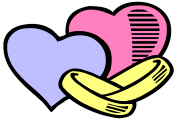
