Rummage Sale 2022 Wrap-Up

After having missed year 2021 (the normal year for rummage sale), three years had passed since our last one and the “old timers” just picked up where they left off and dealt with new challenges.

The building and pavilion were full of items; and thanks to the Forney Family, the pavilion was tarped – which proved timely with this year’s weather: two solid days of rain. That was a blessing as we felt more shoppers came and could shop in one location, stay dry, and grab a bowl of soup and a sandwich. There was a steady flow of shoppers throughout the sale – from Thursday morning’s waiting line that extended to the church parking lot to the 3rd day bag sale.

Two weeks is a very brief time period to set up an entire “thrift store” and then tear it down again. The Parish Building is a wonderful edifice to carry out such a project.

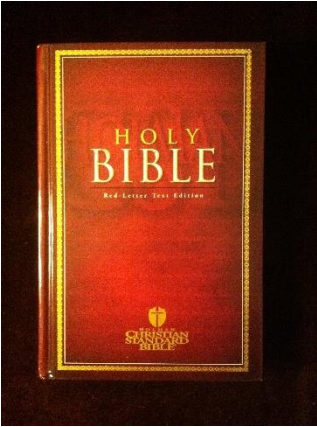
To all the workers and department heads (returning and new) – thank you for all the time you gave to unpack, sort, arrange, price, keep the tables organized throughout the sale, and then pack the leftovers into boxes and bags for distribution to various ministries. Your commitment to get this giant undertaking accomplished and your endurance for the long days is appreciated, commendable, and we pray for blessings to be heaped upon you for this dedication. This year’s team of gents and ladies for the tear down was fantastic – we accomplished this job in record time . . . and then the Romeo guys came on Monday morning to finalize putting away the “props” we use in a very organized method.

What really happens in two weeks is setting up a Thrift Store, then selling the goods for three days, and then tearing it down in two hours and distributing to many different organizations or individuals. Ministries included are: Green Drop (designation: Purple Heart), Salvation Army Clothing Room downtown York, Kreutz Kreek Library (for their book sales), Chrystal’s Place Resource Center (Northeast Neighborhood Association), Hametown Church (make blankets, etc. distributed t/o world); Bible distribution to Love Packages, Salvation Army York Women's Auxiliary Fabric Fair and many smaller distributions to others.

This year’s proceeds are approximately \$14,000 including both food and bake sale. A percentage of this will be given for mortgage principal reduction.

The collection of Bibles @ Chapel Church is ongoing. If you have Bibles lying around that you do not use or see Bibles at yard sales and thrift shops and wish you knew where you could donate, please consider bringing them to Chapel Church and place in the wooden bookcases located inside the Education

Wing doorway. Love Packages goal for 2022 is to send 2,200 tons to other countries. So far 660 tons have been sent to the following countries: Belize, El Salvador, Ghana, India, Kenya, Nigeria, Guatemala, Guyana, Sierra Leone, South Africa, Tanzania, Thailand, Uganda, Ukraine, Zimbabwe, Honduras, and Zambia. The testimonies abound of what Bibles mean to those who desperately want the Word. A few recent ones:

From South Africa: "Thank you for the Bible Dictionary, never has anyone here had a Bible dictionary, now I'm able to teach with extra knowledge."

From Malawi: "Our church, is a local indigenous church which started in the remote villages in the early 1980's . . . the books and Bibles you gave have been distributed to people in town and in the rural areas. . . the material has also been very helpful to me in preparation of sermons. The church is mainly comprised of untrained pastors . . . all the people that have seen or received the material have gone a step up in terms of their faith in Jesus Christ. Thank you Love Packages."
