On May 17, 2023, at the special session of Annual Conference in Williamsport, Chapel Church along with 140 other congregations, were approved for disaffiliation from the Susquehanna Conference of the United Methodist Church. This means Chapel will now own the church property and parsonage and be able to live into a new vision.

I will also be withdrawing as a UMC pastor on June 30, and my family and I are grateful to continue to serve as the pastoral family at Chapel.

God is calling us into a new season of mission and ministry. The world and the church may look drastically different, but we rest on His unchanging grace. We have a tremendous opportunity to reach people who may not know, or understand, the gospel of Christ. Over the past few years the unchurched population continues to grow rapidly.
