Debt Elimination Team (DET) Updates

Encouragement for Chapel Family since refinancing mortgage September 2023:

- > 20 year (240 months) amortization @ 6.25% monthly payment \$3,896
- ▶ Beginning Balance: \$525,873 . . . Current Balance (5/26/24): \$334,934
- > The current balance is <u>\$44,833</u> less than reported in the May newsletter
- > Total reduction in the past nine months is <u>\$190,939</u>
- ➤ Amount of interest paid since 2012: \$622,409
- **<u>Rummage Sale</u>**: <u>HUGE SHOUT OUT</u> to Ray and Pat Forney and all the hard-working rummage sale workers . . . \$14,428.36 from rummage sale treasures and kitchen sales. An 11-day event that involved Set Up, Unpack, Arrange, Price, Tear Down, Remove all that was left!!!!
- <u>Heiland View Cemetery Association</u>: <u>HUGE SHOUT OUT</u> to the board of HVCA for their understanding of "*The Time is Now*" for the future of Chapel Church being debt free! \$25,000 was presented to the church at the May Leadership Council meeting.

- <u>Make a Joyful Noise Campaign Total</u>: \$1,554.95. I would like to take this opportunity to thank you all for your faithful giving to Chapel Church. We are making great headway in lowering our Mortgage Debt which is very important! We are almost \$23 thousand over budget! Although, our General Fund is way behind what is needed for the budget by over \$23 thousand. Our weekly need in the General Fund is \$9,500 and we have been averaging \$8,600. There are many expenses involved in supporting our dedicated staff and taking care of our large church campus so we can continue to do God's work. * Mission Moment is brought to you by the Mission Team in order to bring attention to a particular mission project that Chapel supports by our finances and/or participation. We began in February with Chapel's Shower Ministry, followed by Operation Strength, Let's Get Cooking for 18 South Youth Center, and then Servants.



We are the Durham-Koons family and we are asking for your help with a family project.

Many of us have lots of choices when deciding what shoes to wear each day. However, there are millions of people around the world for whom shoes are a LUXURY. My family traveled to Uganda in 2018. When we were there, we worked with over 180 children of all ages. We noticed that only about half of them had shoes. Many of the kids had bare feet or shoes that didn't fit properly.

Our family is planning another mission/service trip to Uganda in the summer of 2025. One way we are fundraising is with an organization called Funds2Org. We are collecting lightly used (or new) shoes and Funds2Org will then pay us 40 cents per pound. They will clean the shoes and send them to micro-entrepreneurs in poor countries to be sold at very low prices to make shoes more accessible to everyone.

How can you help? <u>*WE NEED SHOES!!*</u> Please consider donating shoes that you no longer need and deposit them in a box which will be located in the vestibule of Chapel's main building and the entry to the parish hall. We will take ANY style of shoe: dress shoes, sneakers, cleats, flip flops, sandals, children's shoes, boots or any other kind of shoes that you have. Funds2Org asks that they not have holes or heavy stains. The collection box will be available through the month of June.

Our goal is to collect at least 2,500 pairs. Would you please help us meet our goal? (Feel free to collect shoes from your family and friends too!)
