Mortgage balance as of printing of May newsletter: \$379,767

Please note that this is \$7,812 less than reported in the April newsletter and the total reduction in the past eight months is \$146,106


- Amount of interest paid since 2012: \$620,488

*Mission Moment – Servants, Inc.

Servants' is a local non-profit organization founded in 2000 by Trent Davis, a long-time friend and former member of Chapel Church. Trent continues to serve as CEO. Servants' partners with volunteers and organizations locally, regionally, and internationally to address the physical, emotional, and spiritual needs of people in crisis. Across the USA, they partner with organizations to send volunteers to repair homes and lives after natural disasters. Servants' international focus is on ministering to children and youth though sports ministry programs and partnering with national pastors to serve unreached and underresourced people.

Their Home Helps Program provides critical home repairs to older adults, single parents and people with disabilities to ensure they have a safe and affordable home in York, Adam and Lancaster counties. Coming up on June 3-7, Chapel is once again hosting the Faith Beyond the Pews Work Camp, by providing breakfast, lunch and dinner for volunteers to the camp. Even if you stammer or stumble, even if what you have to say impresses no one, it impresses God, and He listens.

You will call My name. You will come to Me and pray to Me, and I will listen to you.

You will search for Me. And when you search for Me with all your heart, you will find Me! —

Jeremiah 29:12-13
