**Debt Elimination Team (DET) Updates**

“So the debt was paid . . . for the people had a mind to work.” (DET paraphrase of Nehemiah 4:6 – “So built we the wall . . . for the people had a mind to work.”)

**Encouragement for Chapel Family since refinancing mortgage September 2023:**

- 20 year (240 months) amortization @ 6.25% - monthly payment \$3,896
- Beginning Balance: \$525,873 . . . Current Balance (9/26/24): **\$301,063.93**
- Total reduction in the past 13 months is **\$224,809**
- The current balance is **\$4,832** less than reported in the September newsletter
- Amount of interest paid since 2012: \$629,217

**→→→Car Show proceeds of \$3,000+ place the mortgage balance below \$300,000!!!!** (not reflected in above figures)

## \*Mission Moment – Henderson Settlement

“Creating Opportunities For Better Lives Through Christ Centered Service”

Our mission, as part of the body of Christ, is to lift up Jesus Christ by providing basic needs in Appalachia through God's love. Henderson Settlement.com

Chapel has such a rich history of supporting this special area of ministry deep within the Appalachian Mountains of Kentucky. Our love and concern for this group of people began with Red Bird Mission on one side of the mountain which Chapel supported through clothing and supplies for their local mission outreach and many mountain churches for several decades. Our very own Jean (Blessing) Chubb served in their ministry for two years before her marriage. Ask her, she has precious memories! When Paul and Wanda Saylor visited Red Bird, they checked out the Henderson Settlement on the “other side of the mountain”, and a strong connection was made. We began sending mission teams in 2004 and continued for many years. More recently, our local Servants, Inc. also began sending teams there; Chapel’s Matt Wiemeyer then became a frequent visitor and currently has another trip scheduled to facilitate projects in January, 2025.

But just exactly what service does Henderson Settlement provide? They serve one of the poorest counties in the USA, their location adds to this burden of finding good paying work due to remote living and dangerous roads to drive to reach larger towns. The settlement has a lovely campus with a large facility for hosting a thrift store, a senior center, a day care, a food pantry, a library, an after-school program, a youth program; gymnasium, dining hall, and dorms to host work teams, as well as short term missionaries, round out their campus, plus of course, maintenance garages and administrative areas. They also have a large working farm which is vital to the problem of food insecurity in a very large and remote area of the mountains.

Chapel Church, please feel good about your tithes and offering ,10% of which is given to the Missions Team who, as good stewards, pass it on to committed ministries, including Henderson Settlement.

*\* Mission Moment is brought to you by the Mission Team in order to bring attention to a particular mission project that Chapel supports by our finances and/or participation. We began in February with Chapel’s Shower Ministry, followed by Operation Strength, Let’s Get Cooking for 18 South Youth Center, Servants, DiscipleMakers with the Wengers, LifePath Christian Ministries, Human Life Services and Ore Valley School Support.*

## From the Treasurer:

Please be sure to make time to come to the Family Meeting on Sunday 9/29 at 9:30 AM. We will be laying out some information about our church's finances and current situation. We will also be sharing several of the positive things happening here!

As I stated last month, the General Fund needs consistent funding. Every week we need to cover \$7856 in 'fixed' expenses. We have been receiving an average of \$8421 weekly. Our weekly total budget is \$9790. A shortfall of \$1369 weekly! The total budget is 'bare bones' and does not cover any unexpected expenses (listed below) which has been occurring over the last couple of months!

We want you to understand the need to support taking care of our staff, building and grounds so we can continue God's work here at Chapel Church! We do not want to make a bullet point every week of this situation! We come to Chapel Church every Sunday morning to worship and fellowship with our friends in Christ and disciple to the community!
