Funke Family Service Trip to Tanzania

Eric and Linda Funke and their children Michael and Julia may have moved back to the U.S., but Tanzania is still close to their hearts. They are planning to take a short trip back in 2022 for two reasons. 1) It has been almost two years since they moved back to the U.S. and several of their ministries would greatly benefit from follow-up. For example, the school has requested Eric's help in updating the computer lab and gradebook program. They also want Linda to help train up new guidance and counseling teachers when Cheryl Kruckemeyer returns to the U.S. We believe even a short visit will increase the sustainability of numerous ministries. 2) During their missionary debriefing retreat in summer 2020, the leaders highly recommended that families with children visit the place of their ministry within two years of moving back to the U.S. This type of visit allows children to reconnect with their previous home and to see it as an actual place-- with joys and challenges-- rather than a fantasy place set on a pedestal in their memories. It helps them better integrate their life experiences. We believe this trip would benefit their family greatly.

In order for this trip to happen, they will once again need partners in ministry, and we at Chapel have decided to gather donations towards this mission trip. Plane tickets will likely cost \$10,000 for their family of four.
