

“LORD, TEACH US TO PRAY”

Luke 11:1, Matthew 6:9-13

I. RENDEZVOUS (with the Lord)

- A. We can say, “Abba” Father (Rom. 8:15) because:
“Our Father which art in heaven...” (Matt. 6:9).
“Having therefore, brethren, boldness to enter into the holiest by the blood of Jesus” (Heb. 10:19).
- B. Hallow means to praise. “Enter into his gates with thanksgiving, and into his courts with praise: be thankful unto him, and bless his name” (Ps. 100:4).

PRAISE GOD AS:	NAME:	MEANING:
(1) Creator	ELOHIM	One Who is great (used 32x in Gen. 1), mighty, majestic, and suggests the Trinity
(2) Father	EL SHADDAI	Almighty God Who is mighty to completely nourish, satisfy, and supply us (Gen. 17:1)
	EL ROI	The Strong One Who sees (Gen. 16:13)
	EL O LAM	Everlasting God (Is. 40:28; Gen. 21:33)
(3) Lord	ADONAI	The God Who is Owner and Ruler over everything that is (Is. 6:1)

“That men may know that thou, whose name alone is JEHOVAH, art the most high over all the earth” (Ps. 83:18). Hallow Jehovah, “I AM THAT I AM,” the Covenant name of God (Ex 6:3-4).

JEHOVAH-M’KADDESH	“I AM YOUR SANCTIFICATION” (Ex. 31:13)
JEHOVAH-SHALOM	“I AM YOUR PEACE” (Judg. 6:24)
JEHOVAH-SHAMMAH	“I AM PRESENT WITH YOU” (Ezek. 48:35)
JEHOVAH-RAPHA	“I AM YOUR HEALING” (Ex. 15:26)
JEHOVAH-JIREH	“I AM YOUR PROVISION” (Gen. 22:13,14)
JEHOVAH-EL GMOLAH	“I AM YOUR RECOMPENSE” (Jer. 51:56)
JEHOVAH-NISSI	“I AM YOUR BANNER” (Ex. 17:15)
JEHOVAH-ROHI	“I AM YOUR SHEPHERD” (Ps. 23:1)
JEHOVAH-NAKEH	“I AM THE LORD WHO SMITES” (Ezek. 7:9)
JEHOVAH-ELYON	“I AM THE LORD MOST HIGH” (Ps. 97:9)
JEHOVAH-SABAOTH	“I AM THE LORD OF HOSTS” (1 Sam. 1:3)

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II. REIGNING (through the Lord)

- “Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done...” (Matt. 6:10).
- “They which receive abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness shall reign in life by one, Jesus Christ” (Rom. 5:17).
- “For the kingdom of God is not meat and drink: but righteousness, and peace, and joy in the Holy Ghost” (Rom. 14:17).
- “For the kingdom of God is not in word, but in power” (I Cor. 4:20).

Righteousness, Peace, Joy and Power for:

- A. You
- B. Family
- C. Church (pastor, deacons, Sunday School teachers, harvest)
- D. **Nation:** “I exhort therefore, that first of all, supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks, be made for all men; for kings, and for all that are in authority; that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and honesty” (I Tim. 2:1-2).

III. RECEIVING (from the Lord)

“Give us this day our daily bread” (Matt 6:11).

- A. Centered in the Will of God (Rom. 12:2; I Jn. 2:17)
- B. Confident of The Lord’s Provision (Phil. 4:19; III Jn. 2)
- C. Continuous in Pursuit (Matt. 7:7; Luke 18:1-8)

IV. RESOLUTION (toward the Lord)

“And forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors” (Matt. 6:12).

- A. Confession to God (I Jn. 1:9)
- B. Compassion to Others (Matt. 18:21-35)
- C. Controlled Temperament (Ja. 1:20; Ps. 141:3; Ps. 119:165)

V. RESISTING (for the Lord)

“And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil...” (Matt. 6:13).

Put on God’s Armor – the Lord Jesus Christ (Eph. 6:12-17; Rom. 13:14).

Put on:

- A. Loins Girt about with Truth
- B. Breastplate of Righteousness
- C. Feet Shod with the Preparation of the Gospel of Peace
- D. Shield of Faith
- E. Helmet of Salvation
- F. Sword of the Spirit which is the Word of the Lord

VI. RESTING (in the Lord)

“For thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, for ever. Amen” (Matt. 6:13; Heb. 4:9,10).

- A. Christ’s Dominion, “the kingdom” (Matt. 16:18)
- B. Christ’s Dynamic Force, “the power” (Zech. 4:6; Eph. 5:18)
- C. Christ’s Designation, “the glory” (Eph. 3:21)

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
