





## Welcome to Christ Church

Our mission mandate—*cultivating Gospel transformation*—takes place when people use our mission map to take three steps: 1) **belong** to Gospel community, 2) **grow** in Gospel transformation, and 3) **give** to Gospel mission. Step one is simple. Find out how to *belong* to a K-Group, or perhaps a Bible study. For now, please enjoy the Gospel in our music and sermon series, and let us know how we may serve you better.

### The Gospel According to the Minor Prophets: The Book of Twelve

Our current sermon series is centered around the books known as the Minor Prophets. In general, each book includes three types of material: autobiographical (written in the first person), biographical, and oracles or speeches by the prophets. These oracles and speeches are usually in poetic form, and draw on a wide variety of genres, including covenant lawsuit, oracles against the nations, judgment oracles, messenger speeches, songs, hymns, narrative, lament, law, proverb, symbolic gesture, prayer, wisdom saying, and vision.

The arrangement found in current Bibles is roughly chronological. First come those prophets dated to the early Assyrian period: Hosea, Amos, Obadiah, Jonah, and Micah. These are followed by prophets that are set in the later Assyrian period: Nahum, Habakkuk, and Zephaniah. Last come those set in the Persian period: Haggai, Zechariah, and Malachi.

The series on the Minor Prophets is designed for us to *grow in Gospel transformation* and to *give in Gospel mission* by giving one sermon from each prophet, except for Jonah placed at the end of the series.
