
NEW CHURCH WEBSITE

Introduction:

Q: Who gets to say who you are?

Romans 8:31-39: The Assurance of the Holy Spirit: Persevering Friendship with God

"Paul's answer to his own question ["What then shall we say to these things?"] is to ask five more questions, to which there is no answer. He hurls them into space, as it were, in a spirit of bold defiance. He challenges anybody and everybody, in heaven, earth or hell, to answer them and to deny the truth which they contain. But there is no answer. For no-one and nothing can harm the people whom God has foreknown, predestined, called, justified and glorified...Our confidence is not in our love for Him, which is frail, fickle and faltering, but in His love for us, which is steadfast, faithful and persevering."
