MISSIONAL SERVING OPPORTUNITY

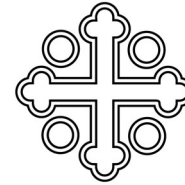

CHILDREN'S MINISTRY VOLUNTEERS NEEDED FOR NEW MINISTRY YEAR

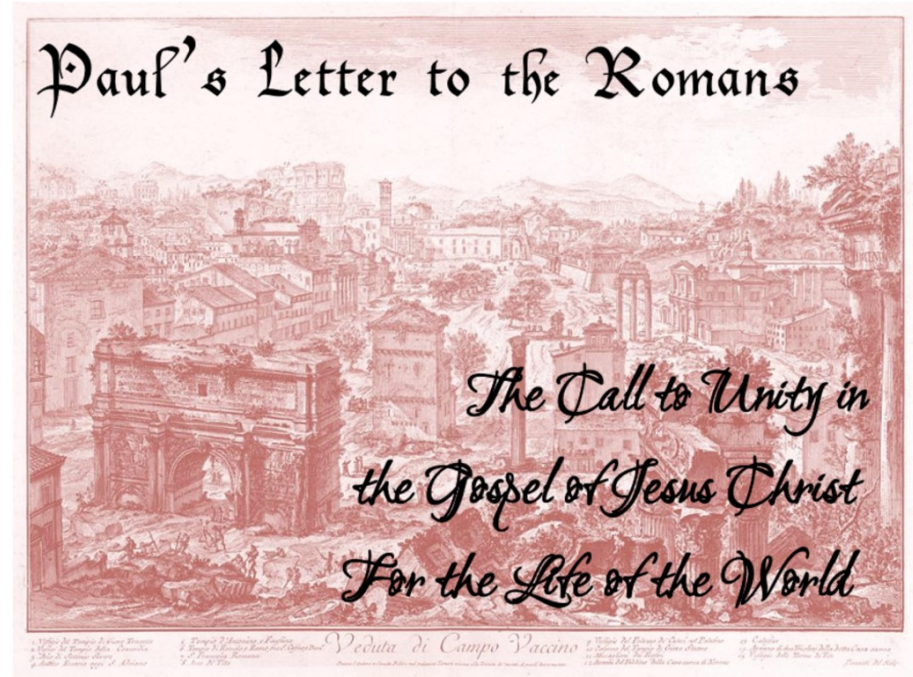

“GOD'S REDEMPTIVE PROMISES AND PLAN OF SALVATION: THE FOUNDATION OF MISSION, PART 5” ROMANS 10:1-4 CAMERON BARHAM

Key Truth: God's power to save is not limited by human weakness or ignorance which allows us to hope and pray in Christ for the lost.

Introduction:

Q: *How do you respond to situations or people that you think are hopeless?*

Romans 10:1-4: Christ's Righteousness and God's Love Eclipse Human Weakness, So Pray!:

“Notice that because Paul believes the truth about God, and because he cares about those around him, he prays. Our prayer lives—whether we pray, and what we pray—tend to reveal what truly lies in our heads *and* hearts.”

Timothy Keller, *Romans 8-16 For You*

Q: *What is your prayer life based on: God's ability and goodness or your perceived efficacy based on what you know or on the abilities of those you are praying for? Do you view prayer as a missional opportunity?*

Application:

Romans 10:1-4 teaches us that:

-God's power to save is not limited by human weakness or ignorance which allows us to hope and pray in Christ for the lost
