
TWO MORE CHILDREN'S MINISTRY VOLUNTEERS NEEDED

Q: When you think about your spiritual state do you usually look at yourself as someone who has been set free from sin or as someone who is still enslaved to sin?

"Our new master, Christ himself, tells us through Paul in these verses to "be who we are" or to "act out our true identity". We are prone to forget who we are. Like freed slaves who still tremble at the thought of being sold when they see their former master approach, though he no longer has any power over them, we forget about our freedom. And so Jesus reminds us, through many different authors and voices and situations and stories in his world, that our former life of slavery is over. We are now his."
