NEXT LORD'S TABLE SERVED, OCTOBER 16

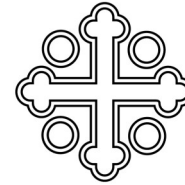

Key Truth: Lord's Day Sabbath worship offers us the opportunity to gratefully sing to the Lord for the great things that He does for us.

Introduction:

Q: *What sparks you to express gratitude?*

Psalm 95: A Divine Invitation to Gratefully Sing to the Lord:

“Our worship is not centered in what we get out of church (edification or inspiration). Our worship is centered in what we give to God. Worship is the turning of our lives over to Him, nothing less. A service of worship, therefore, is a service of surrender. This reality, if expressed, will deliver us from much of the self-centered so-called worship of the modern church.”
