# “THE ROLE OF THE HOLY SPIRIT IN OUR SANCTIFICATION, PART 1” ROMANS 7:1-6 CAMERON BARHAM

**Key Truth: Our justification sets us free from the requirements and consequences of the law to serve God for His glory, our joy, and the life of the world in the Holy Spirit.**

#### **Introduction:**

**Q: *Are you more prone to legalism (strict rule keeping and following) or licentiousness (strict freedom from the law to live however you decide)?***

#### **Romans 7:1-6: The Antithesis of the Law and the Holy Spirit: A New Way to Serve:**

“Here the antithesis between law and Spirit indicates that he is referring to the way of sanctification, which is not by our struggling to keep the law, but by the power of the indwelling Spirit. So for justification we are not under the law but under grace; for sanctification we are not under law but led by the Spirit.”

**John R.W. Stott, *The Message of Romans: God's Good News for the World***

**Q: *What has your justification set you free for? How has the Holy Spirit been a help to you in this new way to serve?***
