



Key Truth: God blesses our efforts to maintain our integrity and honor Him in tempting circumstances.

Introduction:

Q: What circumstances do you find tempting to compromise your integrity?

Ruth 3:1-13: A Desperate Risk and a Loving Redeemer:

Q: What helps you to maintain your integrity and honor God in tempting circumstances?



Ruth 3:1-13 teaches us that:

-God blesses our efforts to maintain our integrity and honor Him in tempting circumstances.



¹Oh give thanks to the Lord, for he is good, for his steadfast love endures forever!
² Let the redeemed of the Lord say so, whom he has redeemed from trouble[a]
³ and gathered in from the lands, from the east, and from the west, from the north and from the south.
⁴ Some wandered in desert wastes,

finding no way to a city to dwell in; ⁵ hungry and thirsty,

their soul fainted within them.

- ⁶ Then they cried to the Lord in their trouble, and he delivered them from their distress.

- 9 For he satisfies the longing soul, and the hungry soul he fills with good things.


