
VOLUNTEERS NEEDED TO SERVE IN INFANTS

"JESUS THE KINGLY WITNESS" JOHN 18:28-40 ROBBY BAXTER

Key Truth: By declaring that His Kingdom is not of this world, Jesus bears witness to the Truth that salvation does not consist in worldly power but in listening to His voice.

Introduction:

Q: When was the last time you changed your mind about something significant? What were the factors that prompted the change?

Romans 18:28-40: King Jesus Bears Witness to the Truth

"To Jesus the Kingdom [of God] exists where not merely God is supreme, for that is true at all times and under all circumstances, but where God supernaturally carries through His supremacy against all opposing powers and brings men and women to the willing recognition of the same. It is a state of things in which everything converges and tends towards God as the highest good...[According to Jesus] the seeking after the Kingdom is opposed to the seeking after earthly things, because it is at the bottom the seeking after God Himself. The Kingdom is therefore a conception which must, of necessity, remain unintelligible and unacceptable to every view of the world and of religion which magnifies mankind at the expense of God.'
