
#### UPDATE ON THE STOCKS

## "JESUS THE RESURRECTED WITNESS" JOHN 20:1-31 ROBBY BAXTER

Key Truth: By rising from the dead to life, Jesus bears witness to the Truth that everyone who believes in Him has eternal life in His name.

#### Introduction:

Q: What does it take to believe that something is true?

#### John 20:1-31: The Resurrection of Jesus

"Jesus' choice of these women [as Gospel-heralds] reminds us of the nature of His Kingdom. It is not of this world. The first century regarded the testimony of women as weak, foolish, low, and despised-'an idle tale' (Luke 24:11). But God did not save His people through [the world's version of] wisdom and strength. He saved them through the cross, Christ crucified—'a stumbling block to Jews and folly to Gentiles' (1 Cor. 1:23). Those whom Christ calls into His Kingdom and sends out on mission match the message. They are stumbling blocks and foolishness to the world: 'But God chose what is foolish in the world to shame the wise; God chose what is weak in the world to shame the strong...so that no human being might boast in the presence of God' (1 Cor. 1:26-27)."
