MEN'S DISCIPLESHIP GROUP, THURSDAY MORNINGS

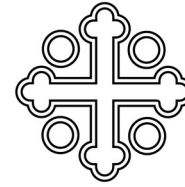

"FOR GOD SO LOVE THE WORLD: OUR MISSIONAL CHARTER" JOHN 3:16-21 CAMERON BARHAM

Key Truth: God calls us to declare His redemptive love for the world through the life, death, and resurrection of Jesus.

Introduction:

Q: *What do you love so much that you would give up what's precious to you to save what you love?*

John 3:16-21: For God So Loved the World: The Lavish Gift of Redemption in Jesus Christ

"God gave the Son by sending Him into the world, but God also gave the Son on the cross. Notice that the cross is not said to show us the love of the Son (as in Gal. 2:20), but that of the Father. The atonement proceeds from the loving heart of God. It is not something wrung from Him....His love is not a vaguely sentimental feeling, but a love that costs. God gave what was most dear to Him."

Q: *What has God given to us that we can freely give away for the eternal good of others?*

Application:

John 3:16-21 teaches us that:

-God calls us to declare His redemptive love for the world through the life, death, and resurrection of Jesus
