CONGREGATIONAL PRAYER MEETING, JUNE 25

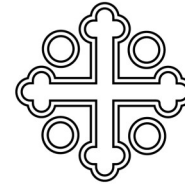

SUMMER LUNCH PROGRAM

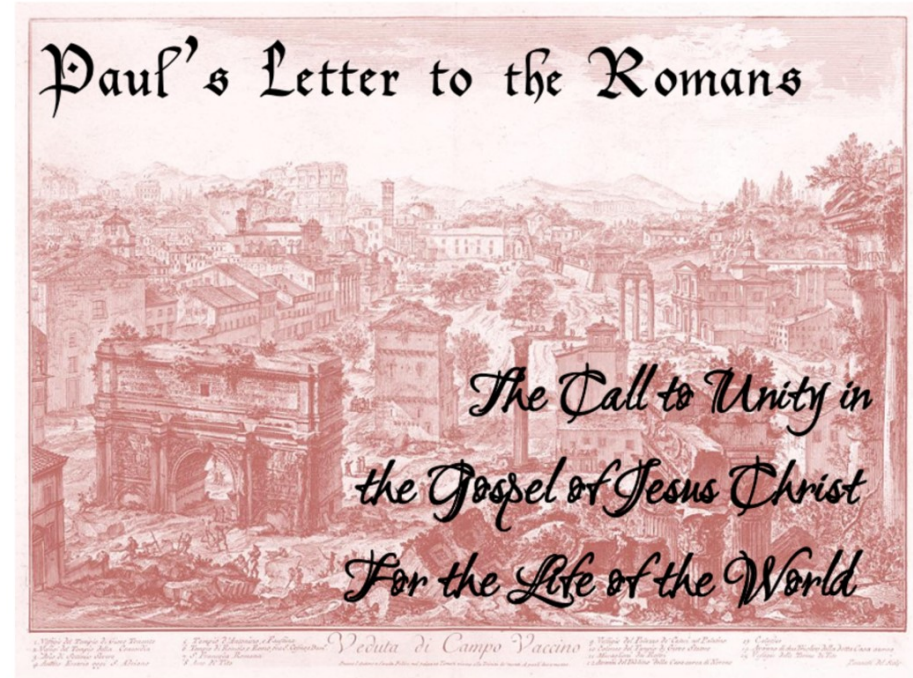

“COME AND WELCOME: SPIRIT-FILLED HOSPITALITY ABOUNDING IN HOPE” ROMANS 15:8-13 CAMERON BARHAM

Key Truth: God invites us to believe the Gospel with joy and peace so that by the power of the Holy Spirit we would abound in hope.

Introduction:

Q: *Which of your enemies do you think have no place in God's family?*

Romans 15:8-13: The Invitation of the God of Hope to Believe the Gospel with Joy and Peace Abounding in Hope:

“(Paul) now shows that Christ has embraced us all, so that leaves no difference between the Jews and the Gentiles, except that in the first place he was promised to the Jewish nation, and was in a manner peculiarly destined for them, before he was revealed to the Gentiles. But he shows, that with respect to that which was the seed of all contentions, there was no difference between them, when gathered, into the Father's kingdom, that they might be one flock, in one sheepfold, under one shepherd. It is hence right, he declares, that they should continue united together, and not despise one another; for Christ despised neither of them.”

John Calvin, *Romans*

Q: *Who has the Lord redeemed that brought you joy and peace and believing that caused you to abound in hope in the power of the Holy Spirit? Who are you praying for with joy and peace with hope in the power of the Holy Spirit to be redeemed?*

Application:

Romans 15:8-13 teaches us that:
