
RAFTING TRIP, JUNE 17

"COME AND WELCOME: HOSPITALITY BY FAITH ALONE" ROMANS 14:20-23 **CAMERON BARHAM**

Key Truth: God calls us to hospitality by faith alone in His grace alone to edify His people.

Introduction:

Q: What hospitable act has recently helped you to be edified by God's grace?

Romans 14:20-23: Honor God and Your Siblings in Christ Through Hospitality by Faith Alone in His Grace Alone:

"The apostle is condemning conduct that springs from motives like selfishness or greed or fear. Faith is that by which one receives salvation, but it is also basic to the whole Christian way of life. Faith is a humble reliance on God, on God alone, for salvation and for the living out of the implications of that salvation. What cannot be justified by being in accord with our relation to Christ is sin." Leon Morris, The Epistle to the Romans

Q: How can you regularly practice a hospitality by faith alone in God's grace alone to edify your siblings in Christ?
