ABUSE ADVISORY COUNCIL INFORMATIONAL MEETING

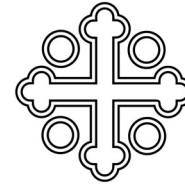

PRECEPTS BIBLE STUDY

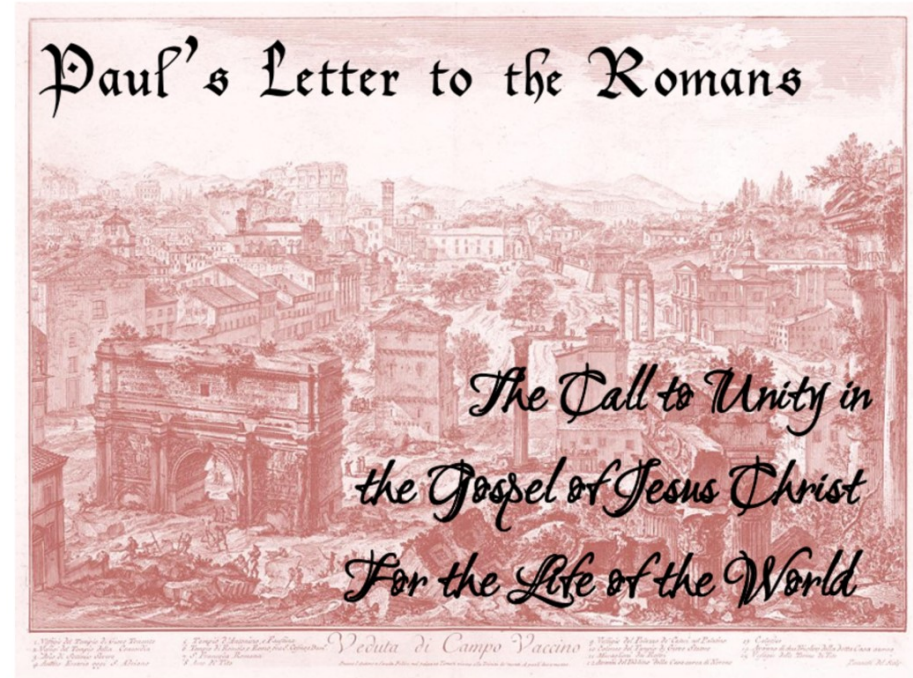

ROMANS 16:17-24

Key Truth: God calls us to be wise to what is Biblically good and innocent to what is Biblically evil.

Introduction:

Q: *Have you ever been a part of a church where there were divisions and obstacles? How did this affect you spiritually?*

Romans 16:17-24: Paul's Final Admonition:

"Christians should unite the harmlessness of the dove with the wisdom of the serpent. They should be careful neither to cause divisions or scandals themselves, nor allow others to deceive and beguile them into evil..."

Charles Hodge, *Commentary on the Epistle to the Romans*

Q: *Are you wise to what is Biblically good that glorifies God, exalts Jesus, and edifies other image bearers? Are you innocent to what is Biblically evil that opposes God, diminishes Christ, and selfishly exalts you over others?*

Application:

Romans 16:17-24 teaches us that:

-God calls us to be wise to what is Biblically good and innocent to what is Biblically evil.
