

Q: What motivates you to pray?

Romans 15:22-33: Praver for the Success of Paul's Service in Jerusalem

"Being involved with people is time consuming, messy, and complicated. From our point of view it is inefficient, but from God's point of view it is the best way to encourage growth in grace. That means we will have to make time for these kinds of friendships to emerge and grow. We will have to be realistic too. Close friendships make it more likely that you will sin against someone or that someone will sin against you. There will need to be times of confession and forgiveness. There will be times when you will need to serve someone, even though you feel you lack the resources. There will be times when loving others and allowing others to serve and love us will feel like death, but this is the pathway to real life in Christ." Timothy Lane & Paul Tripp, How People Change
