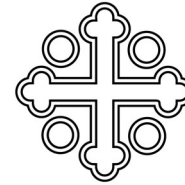

PRECEPTS BIBLE STUDY

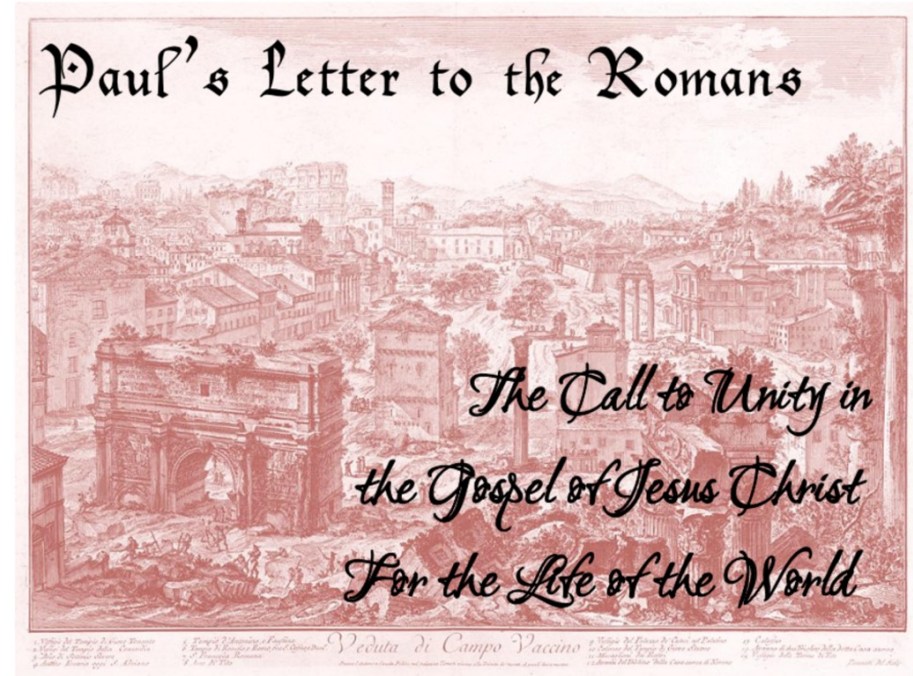

ROMANS 16:25-27

Key Truth: God is to be praised for the revelation of the Gospel unto salvation and strengthening in the preaching of Jesus Christ.

Introduction:

Q: *Who first shared the Gospel with you that had an impact on you?*

Romans 16:25-27: Paul's Parting Praise:

"It is fair then to say that the major themes of Paul's letter are encapsulated in the doxology: the power of God to save and to establish; the gospel and the mystery, once hidden and now revealed, which are Christ crucified and risen; the Christ-centered witness of Old Testament Scripture; the commission of God to make the good news universally known; the summons to all the nations to respond with the obedience of faith and the saving wisdom of God, to whom all glory is due forever."
