POOL PARTY AND GAME NIGHT, JULY 16

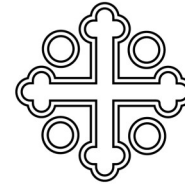

CHILDREN'S MINISTRY OPPORTUNITIES

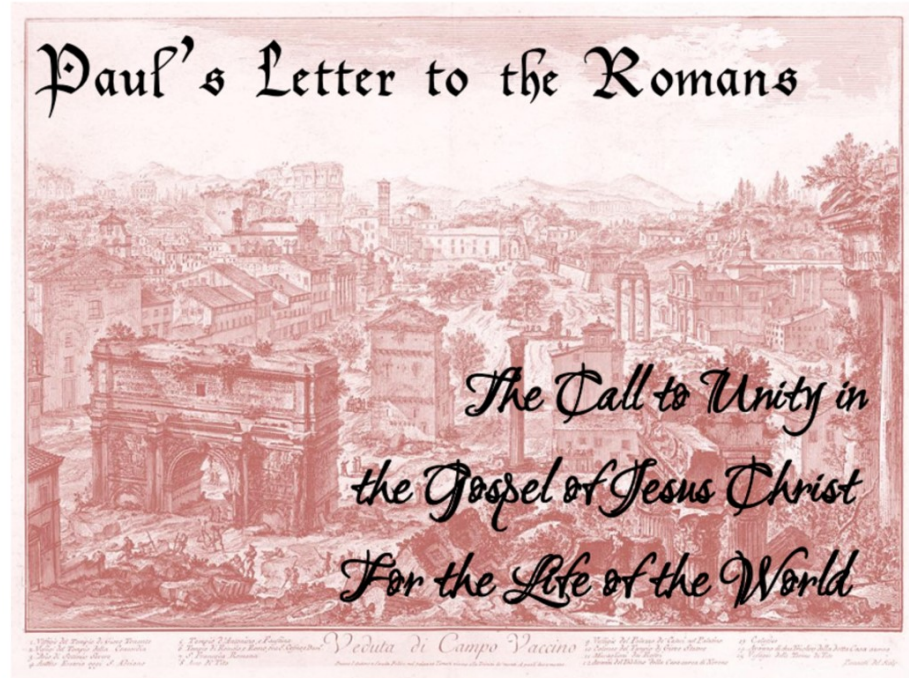

"PAUL'S PERSONAL POSTSCRIPT, PART 3"

ROMANS 16:1-16

Key Truth: God uses a diverse group of people to contribute to our growing and serving in Christ.

Introduction:

Q: *Who all has contributed to your becoming a Christian? Who all helps you in your service in Christ?*

Romans 16:1-16: Paul's Beloved Community at Rome:

"...the several house churches of Rome embody the Pauline vision of an inclusive community: gentiles and Jews; slave, free, and freed-persons (former slaves); elite and non-elite; men and women; from all corners of the empire (cf. Gal 3:28; 1 Cor 1:26-28). Paul has relations of intimacy, collegiality, gratitude, and admiration with these people. Many are leaders in the spread of the gospel: fellow apostles (the term obviously referring to more than Paul and the Twelve), co-workers, and even co-prisoners. They exemplify the cruciform life Paul tries to live and preaches. No wonder he wants the church at Rome to be united in love."
