Key Truth: <u>Jesus gives us the Lord's Supper as an ongoing means of grace to nourish us in forgiveness</u> and newness of life.

Introduction:

Q: What regularly reminds you of your forgiveness and newness of life in Christ?

Matthew 26:26-30: The Lord's Supper: One of Jesus's Parting Gifts

Q. 168. What is the Lord's Supper?

A. The Lord's Supper is a sacrament of the New Covenant in which, by giving and receiving bread and wine according to the pattern set up by Jesus Christ, his death is shown forth. Those who worthily take part

- feed on his body and blood to their spiritual nourishment and growth in grace;
- have their union and communion with him confirmed;
- and testify and renew their thankfulness and commitment to God and their mutual love and fellowship with each other, as members of the same mystical body.

Westminster Larger Catechism

Q: How do you prepare for receiving the reminders of your forgiveness and newness of life in the elements of the Lord's Table?

Application:

Matthew 26:26-30 teaches us that:
