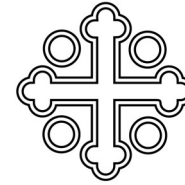

“THE FAITHFUL KING BETRAYED, DENIED, AND MOCKED” LUKE 22:31-65

Key Truth: Because Jesus was perfectly faithful in suffering, we get to pray for strength to become faithful and we get to turn back to Him when we fail.

Introduction:

Q: *If you were Satan, how would you attack you?*

Luke 22:31-46: The King Faithful in Prayer

Q: *How important is prayer to you? Do you pray because your life depends on it, or is prayer your last resort?*

“Jesus prays more wisely, more frequently, and more efficaciously than anyone. He prays more for us than we ever pray for ourselves. Therefore, although we may go through many difficult trials and even fall into wicked sin, as Peter did, we will not be lost, because Jesus has prayed that our faith will not fail. Whatever desperate situation we bring to him, with all of our complaints and objections, the Savior of sinners holds up his hand and says, ‘but I have prayed that your faith may not fail’ (Luke 22:32).”

Luke 22:47-65: The King Faithful when Betrayed, Denied, and Mocked

Q: *Which way do you run when you sin?*

“Humble yourselves, therefore, under the mighty hand of God so that at the proper time he may exalt you, casting all your anxieties on him, because he cares for you. Be sober-minded; be watchful. Your adversary the devil prowls around like a roaring lion, seeking someone to devour. Resist him, firm in your faith, knowing that the same kinds of suffering are being experienced by your brotherhood throughout the world. And after you have suffered a little while, the God of all grace, who has called you to his eternal glory in Christ, will himself restore, confirm, strengthen, and establish you.”

Application:

Luke 22:31-65 teaches us that we get to:

Pray for strength to become faithful because Christ has faithfully prayed for us
Return to Christ when we fail because He faithfully endured the wrath we deserve
