We will not have youth group on Sunday, November 22 due to the Thanksgiving Holidays. Enjoy this time with your family and plan to join us on November 29th!

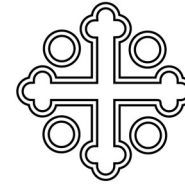
JOB NEED AND PRAYER REQUEST FOR THE WHETZELL FAMILY

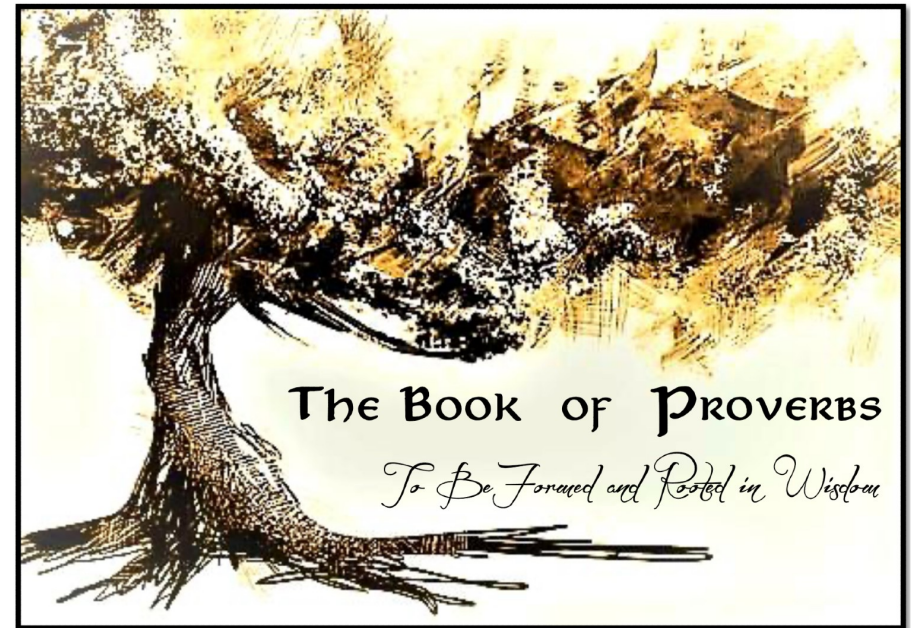

“WHOSE FEAST ARE YOU GOING TO?”

PROVERBS 9:13-18

Q: Why do we struggle to choose Godly wisdom which leads to life over worldly wisdom which leads to death?

Key Truth: Our heavenly Father is teaching us how to discern between the call of Lady Wisdom and Lady Folly so that we would grow in resisting the seductive allure of sin and embrace with joy the feast of God's wisdom in Christ which leads to life.

I. Folly and sin competes with the wisdom of God for our attention. (V13-16)

Q: How do sin and folly mask themselves as wisdom and goodness?

“Wisdom and folly do each spread a feast for men. The question is, Whose guests shall we be? And did we possess any wisdom, or any true and well-directed self-love, it might be easily decided. The entertainments of wisdom are soul-quickenings provision. They that hear her calls, shall eat that which is good, and their souls shall live forever. The guests of wisdom are in the heights of heaven. They feast on the hidden manna, and on the fruits of the tree of life. The provisions of the foolish woman are a deadly, though perhaps a slow poison.”

George Lawson, *Exposition of the Book of Proverbs Vol 1.*

II. Folly offers false delights that lead to death. (V17-18)

Q: Which sins are most tempting to you? Why these in particular?

“The option of dining at the table of Lady Wisdom or Dame Folly, and eating the food of life or death, depends finally and most fully upon a person's response to God. That is the fundamental, decisive factor. None who reject the fear of God can walk too far in the way of wisdom, for that rejection is itself the greatest and the ultimate folly.”

Q: How is your knowledge of God in Christ helping you to reduce the seductive allure of sin?

Application:

Proverbs 9:13-18 teach us that God's wisdom:

- is learning to discern between the call of wisdom and folly.
- is rejecting the empty pleasures of folly and delighting in the feast of God's in Christ.
