#### **PURPOSES:**

- -To wisely advise the session of Christ Community Church as needed on cases of abuse as to how to proceed with Biblically-based wisdom and rightly engage the various available resources for the glory of God and the dignity of those involved
- -To be an available initial resource to those at Christ Community Church to help wisely triage in cases of abuse as to how to proceed with Biblically-based wisdom and which of the various available resources to engage immediately and for the long-term

#### **ENGAGEMENT:**

## IMPORTANT: If you are or someone else is in immediate or imminent danger, please call 911.

If you need help or need to report something:

- -Contact the appropriate authority if it is a credible mandatory reporting situation (See the Mandatory Reporting section below for more information)
- -Email one or all the council members and/or one of elders and/or deacons as is appropriate for the circumstance

- -Please include as much relevant and credible information as possible and include a phone number with available times to allow for follow-up
- -If you have concerns about who has access to your email, then simply request a meeting or phone call with available times in-person or by email
- -Depending on the circumstance, you can expect follow-up contact within 24 hours
- -Do not expect the council to engage or confront the suspected or the accused. This action is reserved for the appropriate authorities within the church and/or without
- -What you share will be kept confidential within the Council with other appropriate leaders and/or authorities being involved as needed which they will inform you of before sharing with others

# MANDATORY REPORTING:

- -Based on reasonable suspicion (evidence of physical or behavioral signs of abuse and/or a disclosure concerning personal abuse or neglect), we must report abuse involving:
  - -children under 18 who suffer physical abuse, neglect, sexual abuse or exploitation, and child endangerment<sup>1</sup>
  - -elderly adults 65 or older who suffer physical abuse, neglect, sexual abuse, financial/material exploitation, and psychological/emotional abuse $^2$
  - -adults with disabilities who suffer physical abuse, neglect, sexual abuse, financial abuse, and psychological abuse<sup>3</sup>
