Dear Family at Christ Community,

Praise God, we are returning to the Ben Robertson Community Center in Kennesaw on Sunday, 5/2! In preparation for our return, we will have a congregational time of prayerful thanksgiving via Zoom on Wednesday, 4/28, at 7 pm. We will testify to God's goodness and give thanks for His sovereign grace to us over the last year.

As for returning to the Community Center, we will progress in 3 phases to one worship service and our full children's ministry. This will allow those that want to get vaccinated to have completed the process before moving to one service. Each phase will be dependent on whether or not it is wise to progress to the next phase. We will factor in the volatility of the current COVID numbers in our area and the application of Governor Kemp's orders in the city of Kennesaw. We will continue the online worship until July when we will assess whether or not to continue to offer the worship video. This is not something we plan to offer long term. The phases for progressively returning to in-person worship will be as follows:

• Phase 1 starting Sunday, 5/2:

- o 2 services at 9 am and 10:30 am with 75 sign-ups for each service.
- o Continue to wear masks inside the building for all but the sermon
- o Chairs appropriately distanced
- o Continue to have the children in worship with us

• Phase 2 potentially starting Sunday, 6/6:

- o 1 service at 10:30 am with no restrictions on attendance
- Masks optional
- o Child care for infant through 4's for worship
- o Men's and Women's Prayer in-person

• Phase 3 potentially starting Sunday, 9/12:

- o Full children's ministry
- Sunday School classes before worship

Thank you for how you have contributed to our church being able to endure the last year! Thank you also for providing many opportunities for encouragement to us through your patience, humility, and kindness over what has been a long, hard year! I look forward to how God will be glorified by our unity and joy in being reunited together in one service in what has been home for us for so many years!
