

Key Truth: God calls us to be faithful as we watch and wait we as He providentially works in our present circumstances.

Introduction:

Q: In what areas of your life is God calling you to watch and wait? What does it look like to be faithful as you do so?

Esther 2:19-23: Wise Plans and Foolish Plans as Matters of Life and Death:

"...God continues to work in and through his people, often in ways we cannot immediately discern, and that those ways may even for a period lead us to pass through experiences we would not otherwise choose.

But, and this is vital, God's providential purposes are being worked out even if they can only be seen with hindsight."

David G. Firth, The Message of Esther: God Present but Unseen

Q: Where have you seen God's good providence at work as you look back over times of watching and waiting? What impact did your remaining faithful even though you didn't know what God was doing have on the situation?

Application:

Esther 2:19-23 teaches us that:

-God calls us to be faithful as we watch and wait as He providentially works in our present circumstances.
