# "JESUS TEACHES WITH AUTHORITY" MARK 1:21-34 Robby Baxter

Key Truth: Jesus's power over the invisible and the visible worlds demonstrates the authority of His teaching and the necessity that we hear Him with faith.

## Introduction:

Q: How do you determine whom you will listen to and learn from?

## Mark 1:21-34: Jesus Victorious Over the Invisible and Visible Worlds:

"As Paul puts it in Ephesians, the foundation work of the apostles and prophets, and the ongoing work of the evangelists and pastor-teachers, is 'to prepare God's people for works of service,' (Ephesians 4:11-12). This was Jesus' own strategy in His ministry, to shape a group of disciples in Israel so that from that group He could preach to the world. The purpose of the preached word of God is to shape the people of God so that the world will see the light of God's grace. And so the movement is not direct from the word to the world; it is from the word to the world via the church. The preached word week by week shapes the church; and the church reaches the world." Christopher Ash, *The Priority of Preaching* 

## **Application Questions:**

- 1. What role does reflection on the power of Jesus play in increasing your desire to listen to His word?
- 2. In what ways are you practically seeking to shape your thinking according to the word of God?
